RESOLUTION NO. 06-09

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THAT NO OBJECTION ON BEHALF OF NEWBERRY COUNTY SHALL BE MADE WITH REGARD TO A PETITION TO CLOSE A STREET OR ROAD PURSUANT TO SECTION 57-9-10 OF THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976 AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Newberry County Council has been made aware that a petition will be offered for the closing of a portion of Odell Road currently maintained by Newberry County and presently serving only one resident; and

WHEREAS, it is further the understanding of Newberry County Council that the adjoining property owners are now desirous of having the portion of the roadway traversing through their property which creates the opportunity for illegal dumping and other inappropriate activities affecting their quiet enjoyment of the property; and

WHEREAS, the property owners, the Oiens, have agreed to provide sufficient right-of-way on their property at the proposed terminus of the road so that the County can construct a cul-de-sac or turnaround so that the motoring public will not be adversely affected by the closure of the portion.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY NEWBERRY COUNTY COUNCIL,

THAT NEWBERRY COUNTY COUNCIL, by this Resolution authorizes and directs the County Administrator and County Attorney to interpose no objections before the Court on behalf of Newberry County throughout the road abandonment process.
