ORDINANCE NO. 10-23-09

AN ORDINANCE TO LIMIT TRUCK TRAFFIC ON LUMBERYARD ROAD

WHEREAS, Lumberyard Road is a County-maintained 0.15 mile connector road between US 76 and Old Whitmire Highway; and

WHEREAS, Old Whitmire Highway is posted by the South Carolina Department of Transportation with signs that prohibit through trucks with eight tires or more; and

WHEREAS, Lumberyard Road is paved with a triple-treatment tar and gravel surface that is not designed to accommodate extensive heavy truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, Newberry County Council, through authority granted by Sections 56-5-940 and 56-5-4210 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended is authorized to set regulations and conditions for County maintained roads.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by Newberry County Council that any and all through-traffic trucks shall be prohibited from using Lumberyard Road and it shall be posted with appropriate signage to this effect. Any violation of this limitation shall be punishable pursuant to Section 10.99 of the Code of Ordinances for Newberry County.
