A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THAT NO OBJECTION ON BEHALF OF NEWBERRY COUNTY SHALL BE MADE WITH REGARD TO A PETITION TO CLOSE A STREET OR ROAD PURSUANT TO SECTION 57-9-10 OF THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976 AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Newberry County Council has been made aware that a petition will be offered for the closing of certain undeveloped and previously deeded roadways within a proposed subdivision known as “The Outback on Lake Murray”; and

WHEREAS, it is further the understanding of Newberry County Council that the subdivision was never formally developed and the successors in interest to the property are now desirous of revising their proposed use of the property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY NEWBERRY COUNTY COUNCIL,

THAT NEWBERRY COUNTY COUNCIL, by this Resolution authorizes and directs the County Administrator and County Attorney to interpose no objections before the Court on behalf of Newberry County throughout the road abandonment process.
