

The Newberry County Sheriff's Office is accepting bid for six (6) digital cameras.

The minimum specifications for the cameras are as follows: 12.3 mega pixel; DX Format 12.9 megapixel CMOS Sensor w/ dust-reduction system; 3" VGA LCD Display; Live View; High Sensitivity (ISO 3200); 4.5 fps Burst; In Camera Image Editing; Video Recording; Exposure Metering using 420-pixel RGB sensor; Built in Flash; EN-EL3e rechargeable Lithium-ion Battery; Computer Interface USB 2.0 Hi Speed; and 18-105mm f/3.5-5.6G ED VR AF-S DS Nikon Auto focus Lens.

Each camera must include a minimum 60mm f/2.8 D-AF macro Lens that provides an exceptional range of applications and high-quality performance. Close-Range Correction System ensures high resolution from infinity to close-ups down to 8 3/4 inches (1:1 reproduction ratio). A-M (Automatic-Manual) switch enables quick changing from autofocus to manual focus. Other mandatory features include Filter Size 62mm; F/Stop Range 2.8-32; Focus Distance 8.8"; and Magnification 1:1.

Each camera must also include an AF speedlight. Minimum specifications are: Shoe Mount; 131' (40m) at 35mm position; Angle of Coverage 104 degree to 122 degree and 122 degree to 104 degree; Swivel Head; Power Source of 4 "AA" Batteries. A Remote Cord to be used for side lighting must also be included.

In addition, the each camera should include a UV Haze-1 Filter with minimum specifications being: An Ultraviolet lens filter; Size 67mm x 4mm thick; Grade of Haze 1; and Reduces excessive blue; cuts through haze and can improve image clarity; and protects front element of lens.

Each camera should include a 2 Scandisk Extreme III 4GB Compact flash Cards with 30mb/s Read/Write Speed includes data recovery software and a Lifetime Warranty

Finally, each camera should include a protective case that meets the minimum standards of: High Performance Case; Black in color; Multilayer cubed foam; Dent and Shatter resistant; Air and Water tight; Press and Pull latches; Exterior Dimensions 21.2x16x8.3" and Interior Dimensions 20x14x7.7".
