

The Newberry County Sheriff's Office is accepting bids for the following items:

1 - Automated Cyanoacrylate Fuming Chamber. The chamber must be a minimum of 32"X28"X43.5". It must have microprocessor control of fuming, touch pad computer screens, completely self contained, and be able to function as a bench top unit. Bid should include 2 replacement filters for the unit.

4 - Optimax Multi-life Led Forensic Inspection Kits. The light sources must be able to function in the crime scene environment by being cordless, must use LED lights as the primary light source, provide diffusing filter for photography, an intensity stabilizer, a minimum of 60 minutes of continuous use with recharging, and a battery life indicator.

1- Forensic Optical Comparator. The comparator must be of use for digital evidence and function as a digital evidence comparison and examination tool. The unit must work on 110V.

1 – Undercover Video Surveillance System. The system must feature an 8 hour, 30 frames per sec video and audio recorder with a shirt button camera and a tiny pinhole camera. Unit must have an officer safety transmitter for optional use depending upon the situation. The unit must have a 2 watt repeater and a pocket receiver with the ability to adjust to any frequency. In addition, the system must have a built digital data signature for the integrity of the evidence court. It may not use rotating media for storage and be designed and well adapted to low light usage. System must include a standard life time warranty.
