ORDINANCE NO. 12-23-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REVISING ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 12-24-01, CODIFIED IN CHAPTER 153 OF THE NEWBERRY COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Planning Act of 1994, codified in Title 6, Chapter 29 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended authorizes Newberry County Council to adopt Zoning Ordinances, to include zoning district maps and appropriate revisions thereof; and

WHEREAS, Newberry County Council, after careful study and deliberation, revised Ordinance No. 12-24-01 with the passage of Ordinance No. 06-11-16 and now desires that portions should be revised; and

WHEREAS, Newberry County Council has determined, in the interests of promoting public health, safety, morals convenience, order, appearance, prosperity, and general welfare; lessening congestion in the streets; securing safety from fire; providing adequate light, air, and open space; preventing the overcrowding of land; avoiding undue concentration of population; facilitating the creation of a convenient, attractive and harmonious County; protecting and preserving scenic, historic, and ecologically sensitive area; and regulating development in harmony with the adopted Comprehensive Plan for Newberry County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that:

Newberry County Council hereby determines, based on the findings set forth above, that the attached document containing Articles and Sections shall comprise and be known as the Zoning Ordinance of Newberry County, and shall be applicable throughout the

unincorporated area of Newberry County and is incorporated by this reference as if set out fully herein.
