The Newberry County Registration and Election Board met on Monday, April 6, 2020 at 1:00 pm at the Newberry County Registration and Election Office.

Vice Chairperson Martha Waller called the meeting to order and John Glasgow gave the invocation.

Board Members present were: Vice Chairperson Martha Waller, Brenda Fulmer, Donnie Bobb, and John Glasgow. Henry Summer attended by phone. Also, in attendance was Director Shanna Proctor.

Vice Chairperson Waller asked for a motion to approve the minutes. John Glasgow made the motion to approve the minutes with corrections. Donnie Bobb seconded the motion. The minutes were approved with corrections.

Under Old business, Director Proctor stated the J B Fulmer Court Referendum has been rescheduled by order of the Governor's office. The new date has not yet been set. Absentee will continue. Poll workers and those in charge of the location have been notified.

The Special Election for City Council District 5 has not been rescheduled and is set for May 5. Director Proctor has sent letters to the two locations not on county property to verify their continued use. Training will be offered online and if needed in person.

Under New Business, Director Proctor stated candidate filing for partisan office went well. Candidates have been certified. The election will continue as scheduled unless ordered rescheduled by the government. Director Proctor recommended board members speak to poll workers to confirm if they will still work. Letters have been sent out to verify continued use of various locations as polling locations. Staff is preparing training and will also offer online training. The Primary will be June 9 and a Runoff if necessary, will be June 23. Certification hearings will be June 11th and 25th respectively, both at 11 am. A demonstration machine will again be available before the absentee begins. The State Election Commission is in the process of attaining needed material to sanitize the equipment and help workers stay safe.

There being no further business, Brenda Fulmer made the motion to adjourn and Donnie Bobb seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 1:30 pm. The board will next meet on Monday, May 4 at 1:00 pm.
