The Newberry County Registration and Election Commission met Monday, February 5, 2018 at 1:00 pm at the Newberry County Registration and Election office.

Chairman Henry Summer called the meeting to order and Samuel Price gave the invocation.

Commissioners present were Chairman Henry Summer, Donnie Bobb, Brenda Fulmer, John Glasgow, Doretha Simpson, Sam Price and Martha Waller. Director Shanna Proctor was also in attendance.

Donnie Bobb made the motion to approve the minutes of the January 8, 2018 board meeting. Samuel Price seconded. The minutes were approved as written.

Oak Grove Presbyterian Church has tentatively approved the use of their facility as a permanent polling location for the Midway precinct, if certain usage issues can be resolved. Director Proctor has spoken with the pastor and the county. Additional information is forthcoming and she will update the board at its next meeting.

Director Proctor has tried to contact the pastor of Lower Mt. Olive AME Church located on Wheeland School Road requesting the use of their facility as a polling location for the Wheeland precinct but has not received any word from them. She will send a letter to Mt. Tabor Lutheran Church located on Mt. Tabor Rd, as they are also close to the Wheeland Precinct. Brenda Fulmer will contact someone there also about possibly utilizing their facility for a polling location for the Wheeland precinct.

Chairman Henry Summer reminded Board members that they must file their Statement of Economic Interests report by March 31.

Director Proctor noted that the voting equipment would be getting preventive maintenance checks this month and staff is beginning preparations for the June 12<sup>th</sup> State Wide Primary.

There being no further business, Samuel Price made the motion to adjourn. John Glasgow seconded. The meeting adjourned at 1:45 pm. The next scheduled meeting will be Monday, March 5, 2018 at 1:00 pm.
