The Newberry County Registration and Election Commission met Monday, January 8, 2018 at 1:00 pm at the Newberry County Registration and Election office.

Chairman Henry Summer called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.

Commissioners present were Chairman Henry Summer, Donnie Bobb, Brenda Fulmer, John Glasgow, Doretha Simpson, Sam Price and Martha Waller. Director Shanna Proctor was also in attendance.

Doretha Simpson made the motion to approve the minutes of the December 4, 2017 board meeting. John Glasgow seconded. The minutes were approved as written.

Oak Grove Presbyterian Church has not responded to the letter mailed to them requesting the use of their facility as a permanent polling location for the Midway precinct. Director Proctor spoke with the pastor and will be sending another letter for their board to consider at its next meeting Thursday night.

Senator Cromer is in the process of writing legislation for the Prosperity precinct to be split into two precincts with the dividing line being town limits. With the Prosperity Outside precinct being located at Antioch Baptist Church located on Rikard School Road and Prosperity City being located at the Prosperity Depot.

Director Proctor left a message for the pastor of Lower Mt. Olive AME Church located on Wheeland School Road requesting the use of their facility as a polling location for the Wheeland precinct. This location is just outside the Wheeland precinct and would require approval by the Legislature.

Director Proctor distributed to commissioners a copy of the revised Bylaws of the Newberry County Registration and Election Commission with suggested changes. Commissioners voted to accept the By-Laws with several changes. The motion was made by Sam Price and seconded by Doretha Simpson.

Director Proctor reminded Commissioners that they must file their Statement of Economic Interests report by March 31.

There being no further business, John Glasgow made the motion to adjourn. Doretha Simpson seconded. The meeting adjourned at 1:45 pm. The next scheduled meeting will be Monday, February 5, 2018 at 1:00 pm.
