

Voter Registration & Elections

About poll workers...

- Poll workers must be a resident and registered voter of the respective county in which they are appointed to work or in the adjoining county. Students age 16 and 17 can also work.
- A candidate or the spouse, parents, children, brothers, sisters, grandchildren, brother-in-law or sister-in-law of a candidate may not serve as a manager or clerk of election at any polling place where the candidate's name appears on the ballot.
- Poll workers must complete the one time online training to be certified.
- The State Election Commission, in conjunction with the election commissions of the various counties, offers training to the poll managers on a statewide basis. In SC poll managers are paid \$60.00 to attend a training session and \$60.00 for the day of the election.
- Hours of Elections: Poll workers must be at their assigned precinct by 6:15 to help set up. Poll workers usually leave 30 minutes after the last voter. This time may vary. We suggest workers bring something to eat, and drink as they rarely get to leave.
