WHEREAS, in 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed a proclamation which designated May 15 as Peace Officers Memorial Day and the week in which that date falls as Police Week; and

WHEREAS, officers are killed in the line of duty --- one every 58 hours; and

WHEREAS, Newberry County Council desires to recognize those officers who made the ultimate sacrifice with their life while in the line of duty.
