

ITEMS TO RECYCLE AT CONVENIENCE CENTERS

Newberry County, SC

Plastics	#1-#7 Containers only Rinse and remove lids. Do not put bags in receptacle.
Cartons	Rinsed milk and juice cartons. No lids.
Mixed Paper	Clean and dry office paper, newspapers, magazines and phonebooks. Do not put shredded paper, tissue paper or paper with food waste.
Cardboard	Flattened, clean and dry boxes. NO boxes lined with wax.
Aluminum	Rinsed beverage cans. No foil or pie pans.
Metal Cans	Clean steel (tin) food cans with lids attached.
Glass	Rinsed food grade glass only. No lids, plates, ceramics, window, mirrors or lightbulbs.
Batteries	Used automotive, marine and lawn mower batteries only.
Used Oil	Every site has a tank for used oil. Dixie Drive Site has a gas/oil mixture tank. Beaver dam Site collects oil from farm equipment, limit 55 gallons per visit.
Oil Filters	Filters are accepted once they have been pierced and drained for 24 hours.
Used Cooking Oil	Accepted at all sites excluding the Transfer Station site.
Metals	Items with metal parts, stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, grills and bicycles. Refrigerators, Freezers and Air Conditioners are collected in a separate location to properly collect the Freon.
